Did you know sharks date back over 400 million years? Talk about Boomers. Zinger!!! There are also a handful of sharks who have been known to show up in fresh water.

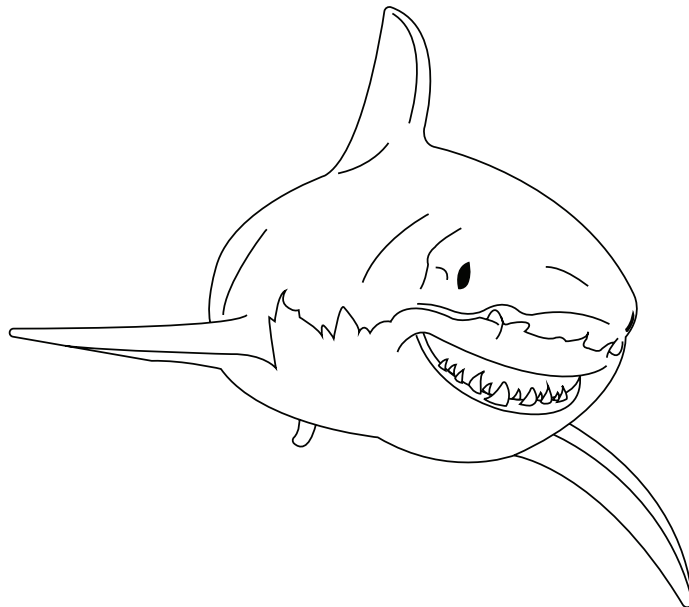

Can you imagine that? You're just floating down one of those lazy rivers, maybe in one of those double tubes, and a BULL SHARK rises out of the water!!!

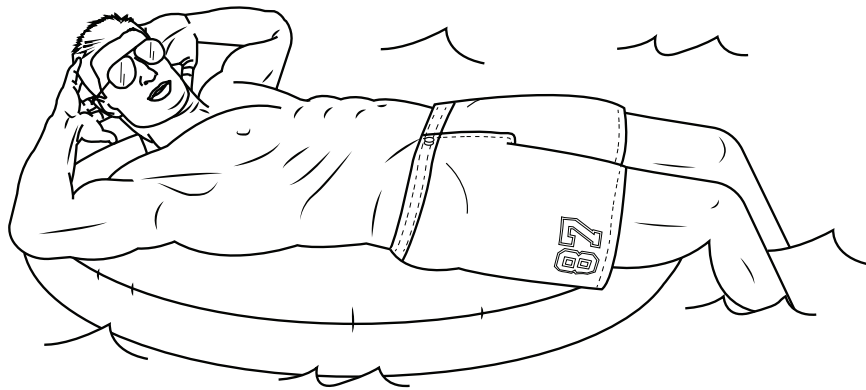

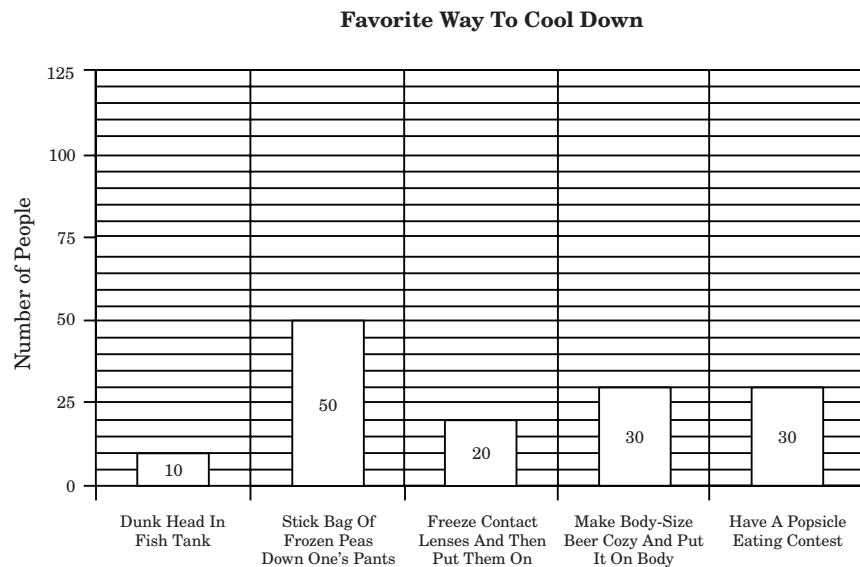

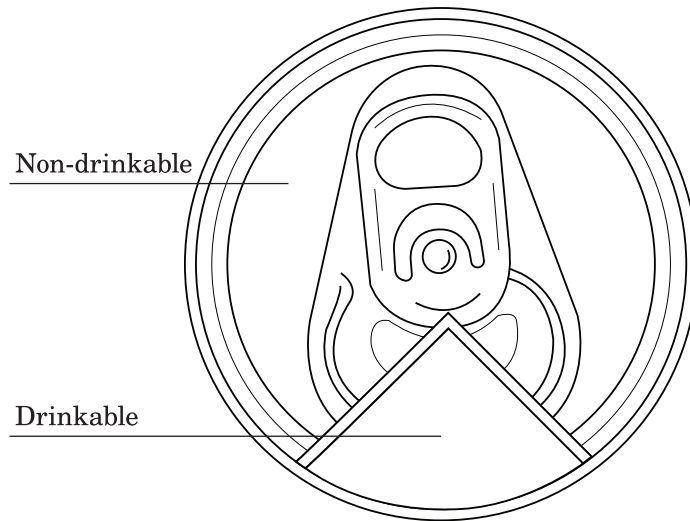

SEC. 105—DRINKABLE AREA (BOTTLE)

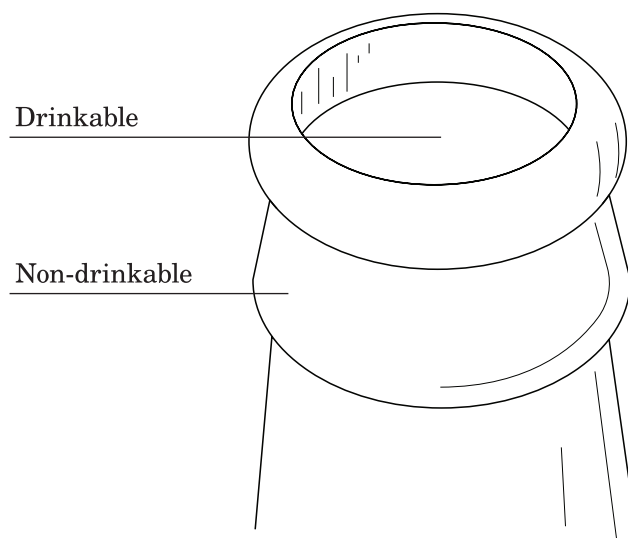

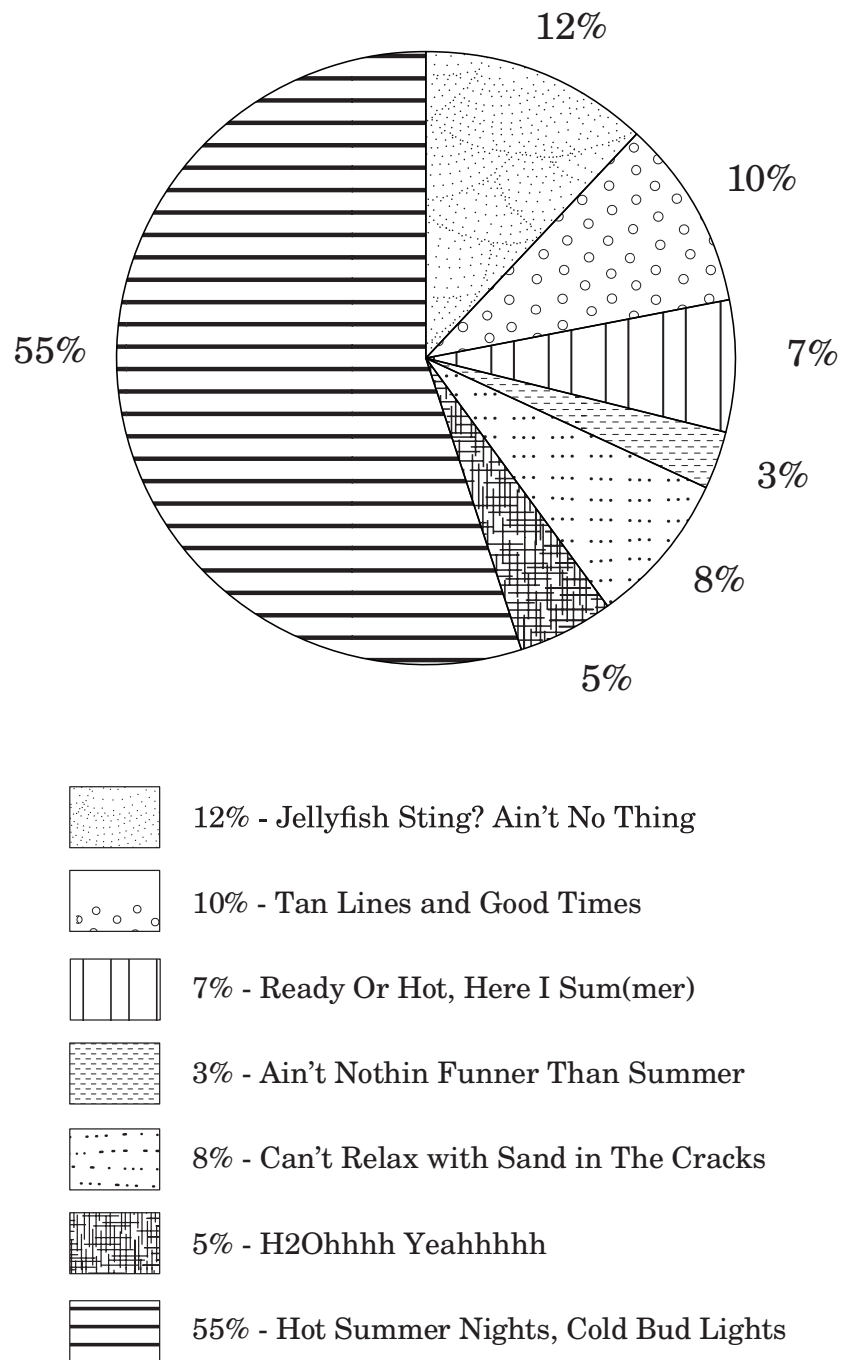

SEC. 107—PIE PIE CHART

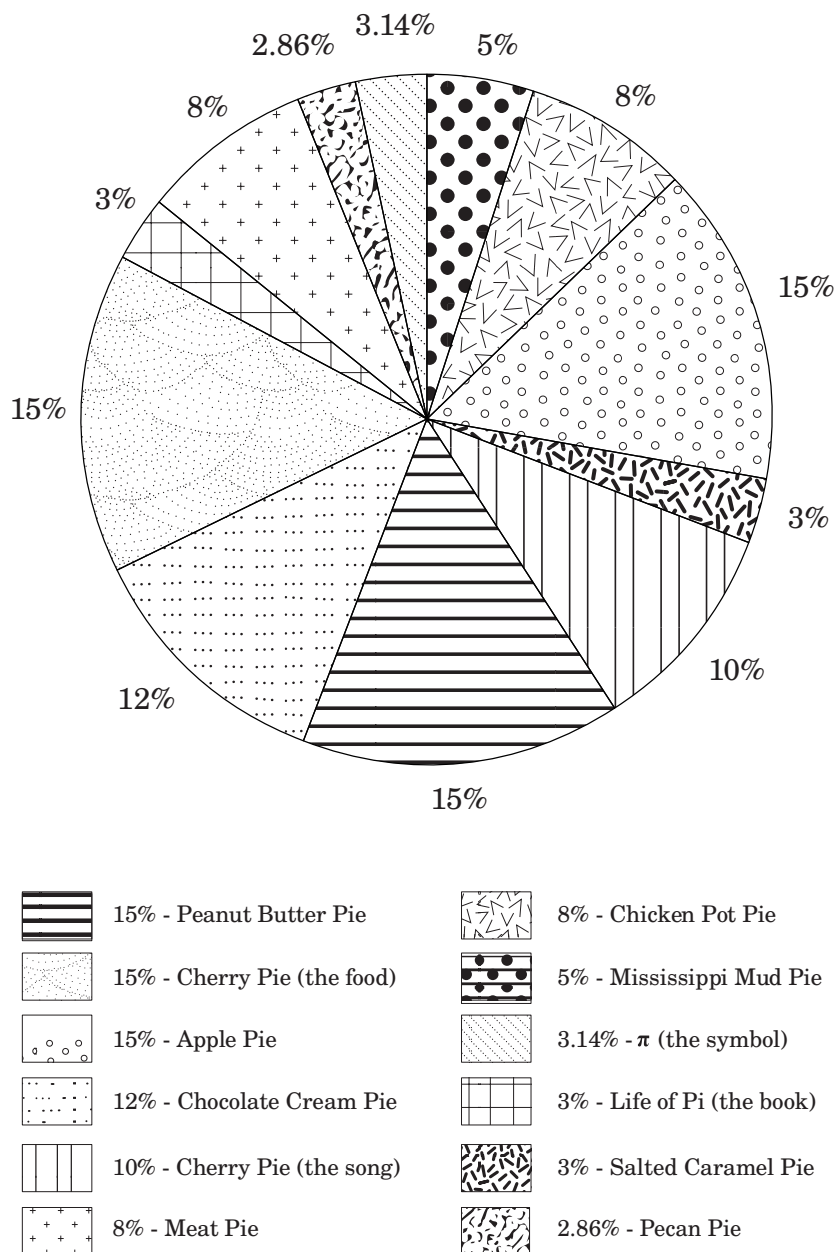

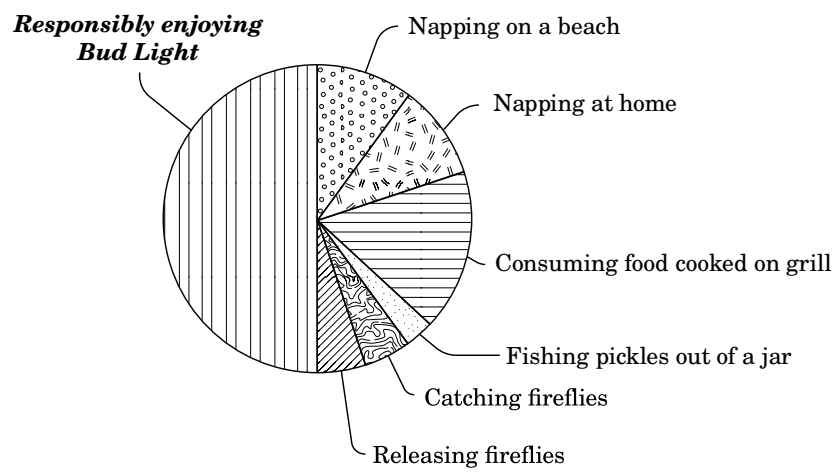
